The Admission Test (written exam) for M. Sc. Engg. /M. Engg. / M. Sc. in Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) program will be held on 03 May 2025 at 05:30 pm in Dr. Jamilur Reza Choudhury Civil Engineering Building, BUET.

- 1. There will be an MCQ type test on 03/05/2025 starting at 5:30 pm. Students are instructed to arrive at the ground floor of the Dr. Jamilur Reza Choudhury Civil Engineering Building, BUET, at 5:00 PM to check their seat plan.

3. In the examination hall, applicants must bring the first page of the application form received upon completing the online application process.

- 4. The candidates are not allowed to bring any electronic devices, such as mobile phones, bluetooth devices, smart watches, etc., to the exam hall. They can only bring pen, pencil, eraser, sharpener, and scientific calculator.
- 5. Based on the written test result, a list of qualified candidates for the viva exam will be made available on our website (https://jidpus.buet.ac.bd). The candidates must bring the original and one photocopy of all certificates, transcripts, testimonials, and NOC (if applicable) during the viva exam.
- 6. Admission of an applicant into a Postgraduate program of this institute is subject to submission of required documents, verification of original documents, and equivalence of his/her degree.
- 7. The Admission Committee retains the authority to decline admission to any applicant who fails to adhere to the guidelines or if there is evidence of the applicant engaging in any form of unfair practices.
- 8. The final and binding decision of the Postgraduate Admission Committee shall apply to any event, situation, or circumstance not specifically mentioned in this document, and it shall apply to all parties involved.
